Dear Parents,

Our summer calendar is all ready to be hung on your refrigerator!!! I'm sure the children are curious of what activities we are doing this summer and the wait is over. I'll describe in as much detail of all the events so everyone will know what we are doing every day. If anyone has any other questions, please feel free to call text or come in and ask any questions you are not sure about.

I divided all activities into groups so you can easily remember everything and the children can have a set schedule they can count on all summer long.

We are starting off our Summer Camp with a Blood Drive and Book Drive on June 20th. If anyone would like to donate to either one of our drives, please sign up for our Blood Drive on line and if you can't give blood and want to donate some books to the drive, please do!! Everyone who gives blood will get their name in a contest for one of three Baltimore Ravens items (a Ravens Jogging Jacket, a Ravens Hat or a Deck of Ravens Playing Cards) donated by the Baltimore Ravens to AACLC for our Blood Drive.

Mondays- Gym, Craft Project and Make their Own Lunch!!! No Lunches are needed each Monday. They will make their main course which is on the calendar. Two special days are June 26th where the children can wear pajamas and July 10th where the children can wear super hero outfits. We will also make a special craft on these days as well as have gym class.

Monday menus: Pizza/ Red White and Blue Spaghetti/ Hero Submarine/ Purple Pancakes/ Turkey Burgers/ Mac and Cheese/ Chicken Nuggets/ Grilled Cheese. We will have fruit, veggies, bread and milk with all meals.

Tuesdays- Water days! We are breaking out the waterslides and sprinklers for a morning of fun. One day we are having a water foam day instead of the slides. The company brings a large foam machine with water slides and a mini roller coaster for a morning of fun. Every Tuesday wear your bathing suit under your clothes so they can just go right to the water☺. Please bring a towel as well and water shoes. On July 11th we will have summer surf pictures by Rodney Beres.

Thursdays- We are having Computer and Karate Days on Thursdays.

Wednesdays and Fridays- These days are reserved for outdoor trips as well as special indoor "trips".

Outdoor Trips

June 28th Patapsco State Park- Leaving at 9:30 to Patapsco State Park (Avalon Shelter 104) for a day of outdoor sun, fun, picnicking and playground adventure. Pack a lunch in a Ziploc baggie and if parents would like to come its free. They may charge parking for parents, so carpooling is best bet. Bus will be back by 1:30.

July 12th Inner Harbor Cruise- We will leave school at 9:30 and head first to Federal Hill for a morning at the playground and lunch. We will then head over to the Baltimore Finger Pier (In between Visitor Center and Science Center) to board Watermark Cruise Ship Lines for a tour of the Harbor by 11:45. We will depart for school at 1:00 and be back by 1:30. Parents are \$11 if you would like to go with us.

July 19th Fire Museum of Baltimore- Our group will leave school at 9:30 to head to the Fire Museum in Towson for a morning of learning all about what our fire fighters do in emergencies in Baltimore. Ringing bells, passing buckets, yelling "Fire" and giggling are required. Surrounded by gleaming fire engines, students learn fire safety and how Baltimore grew to the 3rd largest U.S. city. Lots of hands on activities and the discovery room included. We will also have the children wear mock fire gear and simulated breathing apparatus to learn about fire safety and how to react in a fire by practicing firefighter rescue techniques. Staying low in a dimly lit room, they then “rescue” a teacher or chaperone from the “burning building.” We will have lunch afterwards at Riverwood Hills Park and be back to the center at 1:30. \$10 for parents to attend

July 28th Sandy Point State Beach- We will leave at 9am for a day at the beach at Sandy State Park and Beach. We will set up at Heron Shelter Pavilion on the East Beach on the waterfront (right next to the playground). It will be a fun day of beach time for everyone. You can bring swimmys, balls, shovels, buckets anything you want that day (just mark everything). We will have Pavilion all day so you can either eat there or on the beach. Bring bag lunch in Ziploc baggie. If you don't want to go to beach you can stay at waterfront playground next to our Pavilion or go to the other side of park where the fishing piers are located to go crabbing or fishing. We will leave at 2pm to be back at the center at 3pm. Parents can pay at the door \$4 per person and parking.

August 16th Ravens Stadium Tour- We will leave at 9:30 for a Tour of Ravens Stadium for a schedule tour at 10 to 11:30. Bring your cameras as we will get to see places inside the stadium that we normally wouldn't see. Let hope we see some raven players since it will be so close to the playing season ☺! Bring Ziploc Baggie and we will eat at Patterson Park for lunch. Cost for parents to attend tour is \$10.

Indoor Trips and Events

June 30th Build Animal- Noah's Ark Animal Workshop will come and help all the kids build their own stuffed animal. They have a choice of a Owl, a Fox, A raccoon or a Moose to build that day with their friends. They also get birth certificates with their new friends.

July 5th Outdoor Picnic and Relay Games- Bring a cold lunch (no heatables this day please) as we have a fun day outdoors playing games for prizes. They will play individual games and games as a group to compete for prizes.

July 7th Pirate Day- The children can dress up as their favorite pirate and we will do pirate games, crafts and hunt for treasure. We will take pictures and have a prize of the best dressed in each classroom.

July 21st Tye Dye Shirt Day- We will make beautiful tye dye shirts. If you would like to make any other article of clothing, please bring in and we can do it. We will provide the shirts for this day.

July 26th Speed the Magician- At 10am Speed the Magician will be here to wow the children with his magician skills. I have seen Speed in action before and he is truly amazing. He is not your typical magician and the children will totally be wowed. Parents can come for free.

August 2nd Wild Life Adventures- Wild life Adventure Company will arrive at 10am and they will bring a slew of animals for the children to learn about as well as hold and touch. I'm not sure what animals will come that day since they might be under the weather, but I'm sure the day will be memorable for all the children. Parents are welcome for free.

August 4th Luau Day- Dress up this day in your grass skirt or favorite tropical outfit. We will have luau music and games as well as luau food for snack. We will take special Luau pictures for all the parents to hang on the fridge.

August 9th Movie Day- We are breaking out the big screen for a nice cozy morning of eating popcorn and watching a movie with our friends.

August 11th Bike or Roller Skating Day- Bring in your favorite bike or a pair of roller skates (scooter or skateboard) and we will work off some calories having a day of physical fun. Please mark all your bikes with your child's name.

August 18th- Crab Feast- At 12 we will end our summer with a big party for all the children and parents. We will have crabs, hotdogs, corn, watermelon chips etc. There will loads of food. It's a nice way to end our great summer and we hope everyone can make it.

This Calendar is effective for Ms. Mautrice and Ms. Khalidah's class, Mrs. Tynisha and Mrs. Sam's class, Ms. Shantee and Ms. Tirsit's class, Ms. Conchetta and Ms. Chelsea's class and Ms. Mack and Mr. Dante's Class. The cost for the activity fee is \$190 and includes all buses, trips, indoor activities, foods and crafts. The activity fee is due by June 26th. That is 16 weeks away and parents can pay a little each week in their tuition so it will be paid off by the time summer comes around.
